Subject: NCNA Day at the Legislature – March 28, 2023

It is time again for the biennial NCNA Day at the Legislature which is held in odd numbered years when the North Carolina General Assembly is in the middle of their long legislative session. The Day at the Legislature is scheduled for Tuesday, March 28, 2023 from approximately 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. We will have a picnic lunch at the Raleigh Convention Center and then will walk to the General Assembly to attend legislative sessions and committee meetings. Participants will have an opportunity to write a note to their legislators about their views and deliver it to his/her office.

We are asking hospitals, schools of nursing and specialty nursing organizations to join with NCNA as a co-sponsor of the Day at the Legislature. Your \$650 sponsorship entitles your students to attend for only \$10 (regular student fee is \$29) and your faculty members to attend at the rate of \$39 (non-NCNA members would pay \$65 otherwise). Sponsors will be listed in the program, in the information that we will be sending to members of the General Assembly, on the NCNA website and in the Tar Heel Nurse. Sponsorships in the past have allowed us to keep the registration fees at a reasonable rate.

We have secured the largest possible meeting space in walking distance; the Raleigh Convention Center. Unfortunately, we can only accommodate 1000 participants in this location and reservations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
